BCIT Admissions Review

Option 1: Use of Valid Grade 11 Mark/s & Grade 12 Timetable

- Students registered for a required Grade 12 course may apply **early** by submitting final Grade 11 report card/official transcript & Grade 12 timetable

Note: The Grade 11 prerequisite course grade must meet the percentage grade specified in the program's entrance requirements.

Option 2: Midterm Grades

- Students half way through the required Grade 11/12 course, may apply by submitting their midterm grade

Note: Midterm grade must meet the percentage grade specified in the program's entrance requirements.

Option 3: Final Grades

- Students who have completed the required Grade 11 or 12 course, apply with the final report card or official transcript.
